## Let's Recap:

In John 13, Jesus washes the disciple's feet. In this story, is a profound message about servanthood, and how it relates to leadership. While the world tells us that we must climb over one another to succeed, Jesus says that it's the heart of the servant that will truly make a difference in the world.

## Go Deep:

1. Imagine yourself in the story at that dinner with Jesus and his disciples. What would you feel in that moment if Jesus began to wash your feet? What would that make you think of Him? How would that change how you lived your life?
2. We can love others like Jesus did when we serve them like he did. Who are people you can "love" like that? In what ways can you serve them?
3. Serving others benefits the recipient, but also benefits the giver. What do you have to gain by serving others? How had God worked in your own life when you serve others?

## Live Out:

In our world today, putting on the towel of Servanthood like Jesus did can create a powerful change in people's hearts, in our communities, and in our world. When we love others like Jesus did, it disarms people from hate.

See the world through this lens this week. Don't see others as in the way or an inconvenience. See each person you cross as an opportunity to serve someone like Jesus.
