Let's Recap:

2. In what ways has the blood of Jesus brought new life to you? How is your life different now?
3. Romans says that we've all sinned. How does that change your perspective of yourself and others?
4. How do you think that we can begin to implement bringing the power of the blood of Jesus to those around us?
