Let's Recap:

This weekend, we began a new series about the book of Acts. We believe that the same power that fell upon God's Church in the Acts is available to us today, and that God is calling us to receive more of the power of the Holy Spirit so that we can receive boldness to reach our world with the message of Jesus.

Tune In:

To prepare for our discussion, please read Acts 1:8, 1 Peter 3:15, Acts 2:1-4.

Go Deep:

- In Acts 1:8, Jesus told his disciples that they would receive power to be His witnesses. How have you seen the Holy Spirit move in your life and how have other people been impacted as a result?
- In Acts 2, the Holy Spirit came down and gave power to the disciples. Because the Holy Spirit lives in us, we have access to God's power and not just our own. How does that change the way that you view obstacles that stand in your way?
- The Church of Jesus Christ is designed to be an ever-expanding circle. God is obsessed with finding those that are lost, and He's using us to do it through the power of the Holy Spirit. How can you be a part of expanding the circle?

Live Out:

God's mission isn't for some, but for all. The circle won't be expanded by just a few, but through the sacrifice of many. That means he's calling you to live a life that paints a picture of the love of Jesus for the world around you. It's easy to for this to be scary, but the Bible says that because of Jesus we are more than conquerors, and we can rely on the Holy Spirit to guide us as we become more like Jesus.
