Let's Recap:

This weekend, we finished a two-part series called "Clean," where we've been talking about the fact that because of Jesus, while we were sinful and dirty, we are now washed white as snow if we have chosen to have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. The truth is that our sin is so bad that it completely disqualifies us from a relationship with God, but because we've been made clean we can live in relationship with Him.

Go Deep:

- If you have a personal relationship with Jesus, think about your life before Jesus saved you. How was it different than now?
- Take some time to share the story of how Jesus made you clean. How has being made clean by Jesus affected you?
- God's word is designed to be our compass to follow. How has God's word affected the way you live?

Live Out:

It can be hard for some of us to feel like we're clean even though God's word tells us that we are. 1 John 1:9 says that if we confess our sins to God, he is faithful to forgive us and to cleanse us. God is looking for us to simply expose our dirt to him, and He will wash it away and make us clean again. We can enter His presence boldly because He has made us clean. God's mission for our lives is that we would become people who bring glory to Him, but first we must expose our entire selves to Him, the things that we want to expose as well as those that we don't.
