Let's Recap:

Loving God, and loving people is a call on each of our lives. When we love people like Jesus, we start to be better listeners, more compassionate, encouraging and show sacrificial love—just like Jesus did. Let's embrace this call to love everyone, everywhere. God will use our love in tremendous ways to bring people to Him.

Tune In:

To prepare for our discussion, please read: Matthew 22:37-40, 1 John 4:20, Matthew 5:44, John 15:12, Matthew 9:36, Mark 10:21, and 1 John 3:16.

Go Deep:

- What Does love look like to you? What is your definition of love and where does it come from? What do you think is the best way to describe the love of God as seen in Jesus?
- Everyone of us leads others by our choices and behaviors. Our example will impact those around us. How can you be a leader in your home or workplace this week as you choose love?
- God's supernatural love should flow from us- even to those who are hardest to love. Why is it important that as Christians, we master the art of loving those whom it is difficult to love? How can we practically love people, no matter who they are?

Live Out:

We need to let Jesus change us, so we can love like him. That's the only way we can love everyone, everywhere. Pray as a group for each person to receive the power of the Holy Spirit to love others like Jesus would and look for opportunities this week to love people on the margins of your life.
