Key Points:

- Allow Him to speak how he chooses
- Does it line up with His word?
- Does it line up with the names of God?
- Does it take you closer or further away from God?
- Get your own leading – Let others confirm it
- Consult the body – Church
- Never use counterfeit
- Realize that over time it becomes easier
- Consider the outcome
- Write down the prompts – Keep track
- Remember relationship is the most important reason to hear the prompts
