Key Points:

- Jesus metaphorically compares us to salt: we preserve and bring out good, flavors and make every environment we find ourselves in taste better!

Discussion Questions:

4. In what ways have you experienced opposition and criticism when you stand out, look different, and taste different as light and salt? How have you responded? How do you think Jesus would respond?
