

## How To Start Building

### Key Points:

- Pay attention to what breaks your heart and impacts you on the deepest level. It may be that God has created you to build a solution to these concerns!
- God works in the “no-way”! You don’t have what it takes, but He does!
- Our God is the God of the impossible! He can resurrect divinely-given visions, missions, and relationships, even though they may seem to be over.
- To lay a strong foundation as we start rebuilding, we need to acknowledge the greatness and faithfulness of God.
- When we humble ourselves before the Lord, He will establish us and lift us up.
- When we confess our sin, weakness, and inability to fulfill what God has called us to do on our own, we are actually perfectly positioned for Him to use us.
